APPLICATION AND OFFER

Students applying for Kaplan the Joint Offer Programme will be required to complete and sign the joint application form and send the completed and signed form to the listed Kaplan contact, together with any required documentation detailed in the joint application form.

If the Student is under 18 years old, their parent or legal guardian should complete and sign the joint application form.

Kaplan reserves the right to accept or reject any application.

If Kaplan accepts the Student's application, the Student will receive an offer contained in an offer letter and an acceptance form.

To accept the offer, the Student must complete and sign the acceptance form and pay the deposit and any fees as detailed in the offer.

On Kaplan's receipt of the completed and signed acceptance form, deposit and fees, a legally binding contract will be formed between the Student and Kaplan, which remains conditional on the Student meeting all conditions in the offer letter and meeting all immigration requirements.

REFUND
