## Pre-Masters

### Course options

#### 2 terms

**Entry requirements:** at least 3 years of higher education (in a related subject for certain degrees) and minimum UKVI IELTS 5.5 in all skills

**Course start:** September 2018, January 2019, May 2019

**Course length:** 7 to 9 months

**Degree entry:** September 2019, January 2020\*

**Tuition fees:** £16,800

#### 2.5 terms

**Entry requirements:** at least 3 years of higher education (in a related subject for certain degrees) and minimum UKVI IELTS 5.5 (no less than 5.0 in any skill)

**Course start:** October 2018, March 2019, July 2019

**Course length:** 9 to 11 months

**Degree entry:** September 2019, January 2020\*, September 2020

**Tuition fees:** £18,766

#### 3 terms

**Entry requirements:** at least 3 years of higher education (in a related subject for certain degrees) and minimum UKVI IELTS 5.0 in all skills

**Course start:** September 2018, February 2019, June 2019

**Course length:** 10 to 12 months

**Degree entry:** September 2019, January 2020\*, September 2020

**Tuition fees:** £18,766

### What is EES?

If you don't qualify for a 2-term Pre-Master's, you can take a course of up to 4 terms with Extended English and Skills (EES), including the 2.5 and 3-term options above. You can qualify for EES if you have at least UKVI IELTS 4.5 in all skills.

### Core modules

All students on this Pre-Masters course will take:

#### Language for Study 3

- Develop reading, writing, listening and speaking skills
- Understand complex academic arguments in English

#### Research Design and Critique

- Develop skills in defining a research problem
- Design a feasible, valid and reliable research project

#### Research Project

- Complete an extended piece of research
- Use evidence to support your arguments

#### Skills for Study

- Develop key academic and researching skills
- Practice university assignments
