* These TOEFL ranges can be used to give students a sense of how long they will need to study in the IEP before being ready to move onto a degree program. IEP students will be tested and placed in the appropriate IEP level upon arrival. The IEP placement test may have a different result than the standardized TOEFL test because the placement test requires a broader understanding of how English functions, and assesses English on a more granular level.

Students who have been "admitted with deficiencies" to selected master's degrees can fulfil their English language requirement and will be fully admitted into their intended master's program when they complete IGPP.
