Pace University academic scholarships **2021-22**

Merit scholarships give international students who exhibit academic promise a helping hand with the cost of their Pace University degree.

Direct admission merit scholarships

Students joining a Pace degree will be considered for a scholarship at the time of their admission. No separate application is required. Renewal each year is automatic, provided the student maintains a minimum cumulative GPA and continuous full-time enrollment for each Fall and Spring semester.

Year 1 admission to a bachelor's degree

- The award is based on a student's grade in secondary school study.
- No SAT or ACT score is required to be eligible for scholarships.
- The award is applicable **only** to Fall and Spring semester bachelor's program tuition charges at Pace. Summer semester is not included.
- Scholarships are available for a maximum of 4 years.

Admitted students are considered for scholarships within these ranges, each year:

New York City Campus	Westchester Campus
\$11,000-\$17,000	\$18,000-\$25,000

Please note: actual awards will be determined after Pace's full review of an application and GPA calculation. If a student submits an SAT or ACT score, it will affect the amount awarded, depending on the score. Applicants planning on submitting SAT/ACT scores are advised to use Pace's merit calculator: pacemerit.studentaidcalculator.com

Transfer admission to a bachelor's degree

- Students are evaluated based on cumulative GPAs from current and/or previous colleges/ universities.
- The award is applicable **only** to Fall and Spring semester bachelor's program tuition charges at Pace. Summer semester is not included.
- Scholarships are available each academic year until degree completion.

Admitted students are considered for scholarships within these ranges, each year:

\$9,000-\$23,500	\$19,000-\$23,000

Admission to a master's degree

- The amount depends on a student's GPA and achievement in their bachelor's degree, and which academic college and program they apply for.
- Students with GPA 3.3+ are most likely to be awarded a scholarship.
- Awards are deducted from the master's program tuition.

Admitted students may be awarded a scholarship within this range, each year:

New York City or Westchester Campus
\$1,500-\$6,000

On-campus resident scholarship

Year 1 admission to a bachelor's degree

- Available to full-time undergraduate students who reside in Pace's on-campus housing.
- This award is deducted from tuition for the fall and spring semesters only.
- To continue to receive this award beyond the first year, students must maintain full-time enrollment, continue to reside in on-campus housing, and meet satisfactory academic progress requirements.

Resident Scholars Tuition Award may be awarded each year, in addition to an academic merit scholarship:

Global Pathways scholarships

Pathway program admission and progression

- Applicants to Undergraduate or Graduate Global Pathways programs may be offered generous one-off merit scholarships from Kaplan at the point of admission. Please contact your Kaplan Market Manager for information.
- Students who successfully complete Undergraduate Global Pathways are eligible for a bachelor's tuition scholarship if they choose to study for at least 2 semesters on Pace's Westchester Campus.
