Dual Diploma Terms and Conditions

The ASU Prep Digital Dual Diploma program offers international high school students a solution to earn two qualifications issued by the in-country high school as well as ASU Prep Digital. Students who successfully complete the program will be issued a ASU Prep Digital US-diploma.

- We recommend that each student has an English proficiency level of EXPANDING (730+) on the TOEFL Junior Assessment before enrolling in the **ASUPD** Dual Diploma program.
- The **ASUPD** diploma will not be awarded until;
 - all courses have been completed with 70%+ final grade
 - payment made in full
 - evidence of secondary completion at the student's local school has been evaluated by **ASUPD**
- To be eligible for the university credit option, students must complete all courses with a C (70%) or higher during their first year of enrollment with **ASUPD**.
- Student transcripts from the local school must be received at the start of the anticipated graduation year (including completed courses as well as courses in progress the final year).
- Dual diploma students will complete at least 12 (.5 credit) courses.
- The credits earned in this program can be high school credit and/or dual enrollment (university credit and high school credit bearing)
- Program sequence will be determined by an official transcript evaluation at time of application.
