Direct Entry to bachelor's degrees

Application deadline

- The University of Tulsa (TU) has a rolling admissions process with no hard application deadlines
- Complete applications will be considered after the suggested deadline should the student, if accepted, have sufficient time to receive their visa and join the program for the start date

Scholarships

- The University of Tulsa offers a merit-based International Leadership Scholarship to well-qualified international applicants.
- All qualified applicants are automatically considered on submission of a completed application package.
- Award values vary from \$4,000 to \$14,000 USD per year.
- The award is renewable for up to 4 years, as long as the student maintains full-time enrollment and a 2.5 cumulative GPA.
