Submitting your I-20 Documents

- Submit all required documents indicated in the email “Request for form I-20 Documentation”
- Please continue with this process even if embassies are closed in your country at this time. Our goal is to ensure that you have the ability to apply for a visa appointment as soon as they become available to you.

Coming to campus?

- If you have your
 - I-20 Form from Pace University
 - A valid student visa
 - Are able to travel from your home country prior to **September 15th**

We look forward to welcoming you to Pace University in person this fall

Coming to campus?

- If you are unable to come to campus by the start of term (August 24th) but have a scheduled visa appointment that will allow you to arrive in NYC by **September 15th** please contact intlgradadmission@pace.edu so we are able to note this on your account
- You will begin your coursework online but switch to an in person class once on campus

Coming to campus?

- If you have your
 - I-20 Form from Pace University
 - A valid student visa

BUT

- Are unable to travel from your home country due to travel restrictions

We encourage you to begin your studies online and join us for the Spring 2021 semester in person

Coming to campus?

- If you have:
 - I-20 Form from Pace University
- BUT**
- Are unable to secure your student visa prior to term start on August 24th

We encourage you to begin your studies online and join us for the Spring 2021 semester in person

Coming to campus?

- If you do **not** have:
 - I-20 Form from Pace University
 - Valid student visa
 - Travel plans to the US

We encourage all of our students to submit documentation for your I-20 **but** if you have chosen to begin your studies online, please do not forget to tell your academic advisor of your plans during orientation

Remote Learning and Your I-20

- If you have already been issued an I-20 form but are unable to come in person for the Fall 2020 term, we will **defer** your SEVIS record to the next semester.
- An updated I-20 with the **same SEVIS ID** number will be mailed to you.

Remote Learning and Your I-20

- It is recommended to pay the **\$350 SEVIS fee**. This way you will be able to start your visa application as soon as US consulates resume their services.

The SEVIS fee is valid for **one year**.

- You should pay a DS-160 visa application fee (**valid for one year**) and initiate your visa application.
- You will retain the **same SEVIS ID number**, even though you will receive an I-20 with an **updated program start date**.

Remote Learning and its effect on F-1 visa employment benefits

- Students that begin their coursework online will have no active record in SEVIS. Therefore, an off campus employment eligibility clock will be shifted to the **first semester of physical presence**
- In order to gain an off campus eligibility (CPT/OPT), an international student (F-1 visa holder) needs to complete **two consecutive academic semesters** in F-1 visa status while attending **face to face classes**
- That said, your off campus employment eligibility will be effective in **December 2021**, as soon as the Fall 2021 semester is over

Receiving Your Class Schedule (UG)

- All students will receive their course schedule **at orientation**
- You will work with your academic advisor to ensure that all classes fit with your plan for your academics at the university
- Any edits will be made at orientation
- Please do **not** try to register yourself for courses ahead of orientation

Registering for Classes (Grad)

- Dependent upon the school your program resides within
- **Seidenberg/Lubin Students:** Please work with the Office of Graduate Admission
- **Dyson/ School of Education/ College of Health Professions:** Please work with your Academic Advisor
