Taken alongside any of UConn's undergraduate majors, a separate application is required for these highly competitive Special Programs. No extra tuition is charged.

Special Programs offer a coordinated curriculum that includes undergraduate preparation, followed by optional enrollment in the affiliated UConn graduate school. Students receive one-on-one support to prepare them for the challenges of professional school. Opportunities include unique programming events, taking courses with graduate school professors, and mentorship from practicing professionals.
