2 TERMS

Entry requirements: completion of high school, and at least UKVI IELTS 5.5 (minimum 4.5 in all skills)

Entry requirements: completion of high school, and at least UKVI IELTS 5.0 (minimum 4.0 in all skills)

 Course length: 11 months
 Degree entry: September 2019
 Tuition fees: £15,750

LOWER IELTS SCORE?

If your English language level is lower than that listed above, but you have at least UKVI IELTS 4.0 in all skills, you can take a course that includes Extended English and Skills (EES). Contact us for more details.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

If you're applying to the 2-term course, you'll also need to submit a personal statement of at least 500 words, or a portfolio if available. Our expert Art and Design Admissions panel will assess your application, and your eligibility for the 2-term Foundation Certificate.

CORE MODULES

All students on this Foundation Certificate will take:

ARTS, DESIGN AND MEDIA SPECIALISM PROJECT

- Final major project, demonstrating strengths and skills related to your chosen degree

ARTS, DESIGN AND MEDIA STRUCTURED PROJECTS

- 2 projects in an area of art or design: fine and visual arts, graphics and image, fashion and textiles or 3D and space

COMBINED LANGUAGE FOR STUDY 1 AND 2

- English skills in reading, writing, speaking and listening

HISTORICAL, CULTURAL AND CONTEMPORARY PRACTICE IN ARTS, DESIGN AND MEDIA

- Influential artists and designers
- Historical and contemporary practice
- Impact of environmental, global, social and political issues on art and design

3-TERM MODULES

If you're studying the 3-term Foundation Certificate, you'll also take:

ARTS, DESIGN AND MEDIA: AN INTRODUCTION

- Investigate a wide range of art and design themes
- Research and record findings using various creative techniques

- Complex arguments in English
- Giving evidence of research
- Preparation for exit language exams

PORTFOLIO AND PROFESSIONAL PREPARATION

- Use facilities and workshops within the university school that teaches your progression degree
- Prepare work related to your chosen degree for a final exhibition at the end of the course
