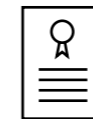

- Students who successfully complete their Pre-Master's Program are not required to supply evidence of IELTS to satisfy the University's English requirements.

What does a Pre-Master's Program involve?

The Pre-Master's Program is taught over two semesters or trimesters. In the first Bridging semester/trimester, you'll develop your study and research skills, and English academic language in writing, reading, listening and speaking.

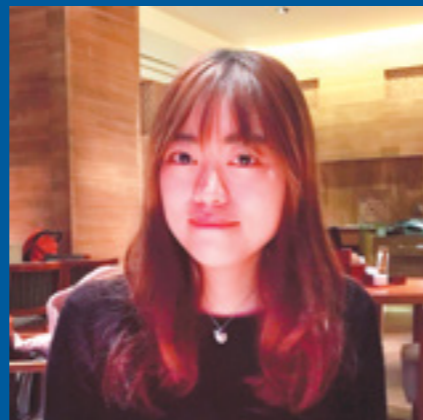

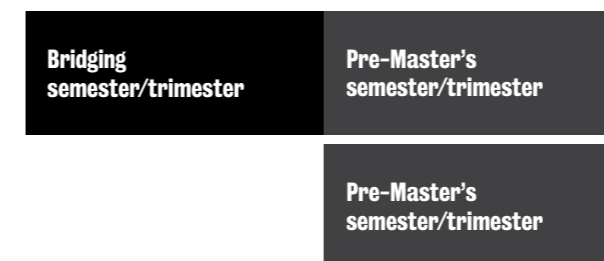

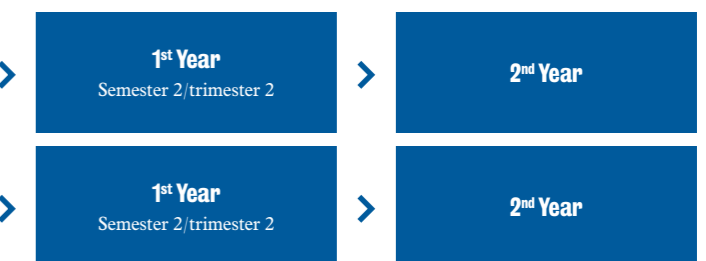
