COMING UP ROSES

HUDSON Architects' latest project, Stoneleigh Road Managed Workspace in Tottenham, North London is a 750sqm purpose built building, characterised by bright pink natural ventilation towers and a shimmering translucent polycarbonate façade. It brings a new lease of life to the site of a derelict housing depot and promises to inject vibrancy into the area by providing workspace for small and medium businesses.

The principal elevation wraps around a courtyard and is made of a translucent polycarbonate, which provides ample daylight to the users of the building and animates their activity to the street. At night this facade becomes illuminated by internal lights, which will further dramatise activity inside.



INSPIRED DESIGN

An elegant Anolis LED lighting installation is now in place highlighting the newly renovated tower of St Stephen's Church in Bath.

The scheme was designed and specified by Kieran Sturrock of locally based Enlightened Lighting.

One of the challenges was to keep all the fixtures as concealed as possible. Most of the units were fixed into position whilst the tower was shrouded in scaffolding and are now in completely inaccessible places, so reliability was essential.

The lighting scheme has given the restored tower a life of its own. When lit, it is visible from all over the city, and it has become a local talking point.

Following the guidelines given by the construction company, Mundocolor created two types of marker lights - 175 pcs. in blue/ blue colour and 925 pcs. in white/ yellow colour, that are fixed one metre from the floor on both walls on an aluminium conduit

BLACK AND LIGHT

The Town Hall is a key public building of strong historical and local importance fronting onto Town Hall Square, which is the main square in Blackburn. The lighting project, designed by Peter Fink of FORM Associates, responds in its white light programme to its status as a 160-year old grade 2 listed building whilst in its colours based programme allows for festive and special occasion illumination. The lighting scheme consists of 36 Color Kinetics colour changing LED light fittings to highlight and emphasise the columns across the front facade.
