**RE.: PARLIAMENT IS UNLAWFUL AND SHALL NOT CONDUCT BUSINESS
BEYOND 12TH OCTOBER, 2020**

Following the advice by the Chief Justice to the President of the Republic of Kenya to dissolve Parliament on **21st September, 2020**, we notify you that Members of the National Assembly and Senators of the 12th Parliament will be unlawfully in office effective **12th October, 2020** being twenty-one (21) days from the date of the said advice.

Accordingly, you are hereby asked to withdraw all police officers assigned to all Members of the National Assembly and Senators of the 12th Parliament within and out of Nairobi effective **12th October, 2020**.

We do hope that the Law Society of Kenya will not be compelled to take action to hold you personally accountable for failure to act in accordance with this lawful request and avert loss of public funds.
