PRESS STATEMENT

The Judiciary's attention has been drawn to a statement issued by the National Coordinator of the Institute for Social Accountability Diana Gichengo, claiming that the Judiciary presided over the swearing-in of Chief Administrative Secretaries while the matter was pending in court.

The statement is grossly misleading and deliberately meant to discredit the Judiciary.

The Judiciary has no role in the swearing-in of Chief Administrative Secretaries.

Similarly, the Judiciary does not play any role in the swearing-in of Cabinet Secretaries and Principal Secretaries.

As such, no official of the Judiciary was sent to State House to swear-in the 50 Chief Administrative Secretaries.

The Judiciary reaffirms its commitment to upholding the rule of law and the Constitution.
