The Station Commander at the time, Brigadier Mlenga, myself and Constable Gama, who also handled Communication Services at that time, did our utmost best to call for an Annual General Meeting (AGM) in order to get the Forum up and running.

Three AGM's were conducted. The first one in Khayelitsha, for both Site B and Site C. Afterwards it was decided upon to rather host two individual AGM's for both these areas. Both these AGM's were handled by the Department of Community Safety, as an independent body at the time. The AGM in Site C could not proceed because of a lack of interest by the community. The Site B AGM took place and a Committee established. Yet again, various political influences caused a lack in attendance and the Department of Community Safety were called yet again to intervene.

4.

The first monthly meetings where the EXCO and Sub-Forums were well in attendance only came off the ground during 2011. We were met by challenges at the time but can freely state that at present, we have a well established and active CPF. Our next AGM will take place on the 8th of November 2011. Only certain posts will be voted in as the National CPF Constitution states that a CPF Exco serves for a period of 5 years.



MINUTES OF KHAYELITSHA CPF MEETING

HELD ON 2011-03-01 AT KHAYELITSHA SAPS, LECTURE ROOM AT 19:00

1. OPENING AND WELCOMING

Mr B Siko opened the meeting and requested Mr Mahamba to pray.

2. ATTENDANCE ROLL

Chairman - Mr Mapapa, Tabang, Marai and Ms Mchane apologised.
Deputy Chair - will arrive late.

3. MATTERS FOR DISCUSSION

Mr Siko welcomed the newly appointed Station Commander, Brig Dladla, to the meeting.

He mentioned that the Department of Community Safety received a letter from Capt van der Vyver, requesting a workshop for CPF members after it was requested by members at a previous meeting.

At this point Mr Siko handed the meeting over to Mr Monakali from DOCS and welcomed him as well. Mr Monakali mentioned the letter received from Capt van der Vyver but also made mention of a letter he has in his possession against Capt van der Vyver. He mentioned that Capt van der Vyver handed the letter over to him. Therefore this meeting is very important in order to set things straight with regards to the responsibilities of the CPF and where their power ends. He mentioned that this letter against Capt van der Vyver is but one of the issues. Should the Forum have had problems with Capt van der Vyver, they should discuss it with the Station Commander and not amongst themselves and then hand over to the officer.

He mentioned the following points with regards to the responsibilities of the CPF members :

* The CPF must work hand & hand with the Police Communication Desk on the police and other Agencies.

* The CPF must mobilize the Community to join the Neighborhood Watches. They cannot tell the Police what to do. Should they (CPF) wish to do a project, they need to have planning meetings with the Sector Commanders so that there is no duplication.

* The members are not joined as individuals. If anyone wish to be a member of the CPF, they should go through a screening part with regards to possible criminal record.

* The Chairperson or designated member should attend police management meetings, but not those where special operations are planned. They need to attend in order to take note of certain projects with regards to crime prevention in the station precinct.

At this point in time, Mr Monakali read all the responsibilities of each member of the CPF by means of a copied power-point presentation. Members received copies.

- * Additional members should also receive responsibilities through the meetings by the Chairperson and Station Commander. The police have the obligation or mandate to lead certain issues. The CPF cannot tell the police what they can do. They will lead by example.
- * The Sector Chairperson, Sector Commanders have a seat on the EXCO. They need to be involved in monthly meetings. The CPF can however decide to involve them on a fortnight- or monthly basis.

Mr Siko that they need clarity on equipment and that this point was part of the letter against her. They mentioned that they were also not introduced to the new Station Commander before the meeting. He mentioned that they are unhappy about the letter being with DOCS. They know now that these letters should be sent to the Station Commander and not the member.

Some of the members mentioned that Capt van der Vyver always assist the police where possible.

Mr Siko mentioned that they are working with the Communication - and Social Crime Prevention Desk and explained the reason for the letter. He also mentioned that they want to own their own equipment. Lt-Col Maseti gave them her plan to run with it. They are going to discuss this document afterwards as this is not on the Agenda and questioned why there is no Agenda. Mr Monakali explained that this is a special meeting as it was previously requested by the CPF members in a previous meeting. He will also check up on the equipment but mentioned that it need to be managed by both parties, being the police and CPF. They cannot owe it. Equipment no longer in use, should be returned in order for others to make use of it.

Capt van der Vyver reacted by saying that this meeting was in fact requested by CPF members and that they wanted a Workshop on their roles and responsibilities.

The workshop could not take place as a result of the Elections. She mentioned that she is very hurt and disappointed about the letter as she is working hard for the CPF. She mentioned that she did not want to take this personal but it's the way she felt.

Brigadier Dladla responded by introducing himself as new Commander of Khayelitsha. He mentioned that they are suppose to have monthly CPF meetings but propose that there is no more meetings for the next two months as a result of the Elections. May there be problems, he can be seen in order to deal with them or an urgent meeting should be called.

He also thanked Mr Monakali and made mention about the Workshop. Mr Monakali indicated that he will liaise with the CPF on a suitable date and time for the workshop as he will also organize refreshments for the day.

Meeting adjourned at 19:30

MINUTES OF KHAYELITSHA CPF MEETING

HELD ON 2011-07-28 AT KHAYELITSHA SAPS, LECTURE ROOM AT 18:00

1. OPENING AND WELCOMING

Brig Dladla opened the meeting and welcomed all present. He mentioned the fact that the Chair- or Vice Chair is not present therefore he should lead the meeting.

2. ATTENDANCE ROLL

Chairman - Mr Mapapa. Capt van der Vyver mentioned that Mr Mapapa came to see her to inform her that he will no longer be able to attend to the meetings as a result of his work. Another Chair needs to be co-opted.

3. APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MINUTES

4. MATTERS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MINUTES

4.1 Workshop held by DOCS -

The floor reported that the workshop was a failure. Some of the members only learned about the workshop a day in advance. Police Management were also not informed. Mr Mtotywa requests that the police inform them of future events and that they must form part of meetings/events.

Brigadier Dladla mentioned that meetings held by the CPF where only their members are present and not police must end here and now. The CPF are a two partnership structure and need to remain as such. Meetings must be held where both the Station Commander as well as the Sector Commanders are involved. Mr Mtotywa confirms this and mention that he is not here to work on his own but with the police. Mr Giyama mentions that he finds it strange that only additional members are present and not the EXCO.

Mr Mtotywa mentions that he also finds it strange that at a previous meeting held by only CPF members, the top 5 were present but not here at this meeting.

Brig Dladla mentions that they must host another workshop and envisage it to be held on the 27th and/or 28th of August 2011. Mr Mtotywa will assist in organising a venue for the event. Capt van der Vyver to apply for the necessary approval from the Provincial Office in this regard.

Brigadier Dladla also mentioned the fact that should a member not attend for three (3) consecutive meetings, he/she will be deemed as dismissed and another member may be co-opted into that position. As CPF members, they also need to have knowledge regarding the crime in the area. And not only attend meetings but assist the Police in fighting the battle against crime.

4. MATTERS FOR DISCUSSION

4.1 Year Planner -

Capt van der Vyver read the future events with regards to the 'Year Planner for Khayelitsha'. Ms Mosana reported that they felt that the members are not all assisting but they hosted an event over the past weekend where they hosted a 'Street-Theatre against Crime'. It was a huge success but that the venue was a problem as it is at times double booked or a fee charged.

Brig Dladla mentions that the members need to follow the document in conjunction with Cst Jacobs at Social Crime Prevention. (Year Planner attached)

4.2 Bank Statements -

Brig Dladla mention that the station received a letter from FNB stating that there is an amount on an inactive account. Capt avn der Vyver gave a background on the fact that the previous EXCO did not inform her about this account, nor did they have any financial registers. She will contact FNB to find out how to relocate that amount to the current account at Standard Bank. Mr Mtotywa mentioned that he will call on the Treasurer to visit Capt van der Vyver.

4.3 Crime Report -

Brig Dladla gave an overview of the crime situation and made mention of the vigilantism problem in Site C. These murders are escalating and we need to meet with the residents of Site C. Police numbers and patrols in the area has been made double in order for prevention. They will also use the AVL system (Tracker) to see where vehicles were during these vigilantism murders.

Brig Dladla mentions a meeting to be held with the residents of Site C on the following Wednesday and request that all CPF members be present. He also mentions that Theft of Motor Vehicle is becoming a problem in Site C as well as their assistance is needed to attend to this as well.

Mention is also made of the political problem in Site C regarding two main groupings and this makes the problem even worse.

Another problem that needs urgent attention is the matter regarding school groupings 'gangs' in the area. Col Abels is responsible for this and they already had many meetings where the parents, schools and other organisations were present in order to prevent this from taking place. Col Abels mentions that it is in fact children not attending to school that is the initiators of these gang-fights and intimidate scholars. The CPF needs to attend as a matter of urgency to this matter. Parents that are not seeing that their children are attending school needs to be dealt with as it is an offence. The matter of 'Missing Children' are also a huge problem and needs CPF assistance as well.

4.4 Gender Free Conference on the 5th and 6th of August 2011 -

Brig Dladla gave feedback on this event and mentioned that the organization went to the Office of the Deputy Minister of Police, in order to seek assistance in this matter after it was found that a young lesbian lady had been raped and killed in Khayelitsha. It is called 'corrective rape'. This conference is to call for an end to these incidents. It will be held at the Matthew Goniwe High School Hall on the Friday from 16:00 till 21:00 and Saturday from 09:00 to 17:00.

4.5 Cluster CPF Board Meeting -

Brig Dladla mentions that the newly appointed Cluster Commander, Maj-Gen Ndlovu, will host the first of the Cluster Board meetings on the 18th of August 2011.

4.6 Office space for CPF members -

Brig Dladla spoke on the problem of office space at present and mentioned that there is no space available for the CPF. He will however see to this as soon as the new building has been handed over to the station. Capt van der Vyver to remind him.

4.7 Date and Time of meetings -

A set date needs to be decided upon after the Cluster meeting in order to see that these two meetings does not fall on the same day. Time of the meetings will be at 18:00. Meetings to be no longer than 1 hour and 30 minutes.

4.5 Missing Children -

This matter needs intervention by the CPF. Parents needs to be held accountable for their children. They need to immediately report their children as missing and not search for the child themselves. The CPF needs to look at a program/project to address the matter. Children also become involved with drugs and start stealing from their parents. This matter also needs serious intervention.

5. MATTERS FOR DISCUSSION

5.1 Projects -

Ms Gxasheka mentioned that only a few work together to host projects but that it is the responsibility of all connected to the CPF. The CPF needs to pull up their socks to make a difference in the community.

Brig Dladla suggested that a small group be called to form a planning committee for all projects. These members may then call on others to assist. The Planning Committee was formed and consists of the following members ; Z Gxasheka, Z Yaphi, L Mosana and Cst Jacobs.

Cst Jacobs informed the house of a meeting planned for the 26th at 09:00 at the Blue Hall, Site C, in connection with the vigilantism murders experienced in Site C. Members of the Justice Department will address the community in order to prevent them from taking the law into their own hands.

5.2 Feedback from Sub-Forums -

5.2.1 Sector 5 :

An Imbizo was held on the 9th of August but had to be called-off as a result of bad attendance. New arrangements to be made. They have drug problems as well as common robberies. They need to discuss this at their meeting. They also mentioned that they requested the Somalian shop owners to close early.

5.2.2 Sector 3 :

They started to patrol their own area as from 04:00 up to 07:00. This made a big difference as it brought robberies down. They mentioned that they receive information and that the police then need to follow-up. Brig Dladla mentioned that they need to come forward with the information and report it at the station. He also said that the patrollers may not beat the community and should they patrol, a police official needs to accompany them in order to make use of the radio, should they need back-up. Patrollers may not book out police radio's.

5.2.3 Sector 6 :

They spoke on the crime in Site C and made mention of Reservists working with them. They feel that they take over and undermine the members of the community. They do not want the Reservists to accompany them anymore and want to patrol alone or patrol with Metro Police members. They wish to meet with VPUU to address the matter about radios.

5.3 Feedback from Metro Police -

The community needs assistance from the Metro Police as well. They have 24 members at this stage doing patrols. They are divided into two groups, and therefore only 12 are available to cover the entire Khayelitsha area. Lt-Col Somtsewu committed himself to meet with all the support role-players like Metro, Traffic and CPF to discuss the way forward. The Metro Police are needed especially during weekends.

5.4 Crime Report -

Colonel Abels gave feedback on crime and mentioned that the police experience an escalation in murders, attempted murders, drug abuse and armed robberies at shops. He mentioned the main crime tendencies experienced in the different Sectors. They are as follows :

- Sector 1 : Burglaries in Kwezi and Bongweni, Drugs in Taiwan
- Sector 2 : Murders, Robberies
- Sector 3 : Contact Crimes
- Sector 4 : House Robberies in RR Section, Murders during Saturday evenings
- Sector 5 : Business Robberies
- Sector 6 : Business Robberies, Burglaries

6. GENERAL

6.1 Parolees -

Applications were discussed but the floor felt that the CPF members who had training at Pollsmoor needs to meet with Lt-Col Brooks in order to discuss these applications.

6.2 Date and Time of meetings -

The meeting decided on the last Thursday of each month at 18:00. Meetings should not last longer than 1 hour and 30 minutes.







1. OPENING AND WELCOMING

Mr Mthotywa opened the meeting.

Mr Siphon mentioned that the absenteeism of the people who are holding positions in the CPF is not acceptable. CPF members should not have too many positions they hold outside the CPF as this cause them not to attend monthly meetings. Approved/Seconded - No minutes available

4. MATTERS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MINUTES

5. MATTERS FOR DISCUSSION

5.1 CPF Office -

Mr Siko mentioned that he felt that Police Management were undermining the CPF as they had to hold meetings in the open as the lecture room was not available. He said that nobody is telling them anything about the moving of offices, etc. and that they felt they need to be told about matters regarding the station. He also mentioned that they also do not have any office to use as the CPF. He felt that there is a gap between police and the CPF and that it needs to be rectified.

Brig Dladla answered that police are not undermining the CPF but that the situation was out of his hands. He was instructed by the Provincial and National office to place certain units, who never formed part of the station in the past, at the new building. This caused major problems. Where members could have been single-seated in the new offices, it caused them to be seated together yet again.

The Brigadier also spoke on the lecture room and mentioned that he discussed the matter with the delegation who came to see him with regards to a meeting venue. He explained to them that he could not give them keys to the new building but, in the mean time, gave them a temporary solution by requesting them to make use of the wooden couches under the roofing in front of A 7. He mentioned that the Detectives host their parades there each morning.

Mr Siko mentioned that he still feels that they had to be informed about the move in the first place as this misunderstanding could have been avoided.

Brigadier Dladla mentioned that there is in fact an office for the CPF that will be located in one of the park-homes, but that an entrance needs to be shared by both the CPF and a police union delegation.

5.2 Feedback from Sub-Forums -

5.2.1 W/O Xongo mentioned that he has a problem in his Sector as he has no sub-forum as yet. His crime is mounting and is a concern for him. He also has a problem that he has two area's, being Site C and B. The meeting agreed on a date, being the 10th of November 2011 at the Blue Hall in Site C.
Mention was also made with regards to VPUU that needed to form part of the CPF meeting as they could answer on the payment of patrollers. CPF to organise the someone should attend.

5.2.2 Sector Commander for Sector 2 mentioned that there are too many unlicensed firearms in Site C. He mentioned that persons are scared to come forward with information regarding Domestic Violence, Rape and Robbery. Many of them do not even come forward to report these incidents.

5.2.3 The Secretary for Sector 5 reported that Gangsterism is a huge problem in their area. There are meetings held with parents and schools in order to prevent and/or solve the problem. They mentioned that there was a case registered where police allegedly beat up a young boy. Brigadier mentions that they do not need to discuss this as a case has already been opened and investigated at present.

5.4 Crime Report -

Brigadier Dladla gave an overview of the current crime situation being experienced at present and how the CPF should assist.

6. GENERAL

Mention was made with regards to the attitude of young members towards the members of the Forum. Brigadier mentioned that the problem is that members do not know the CPF members. He invited all Chairpersons to attend to the Station Lecture on the 16th of November at 08:00 in order to introduce them to the members. The Chairperson also mentioned that he felt the same about the situation. Members do not treat him well. Brigadier mentioned that this meeting could solve the problem.

The Vice Chairperson, Mr Mbulali urged the Management to work together with the CPF and that he felt that their property needed to be taken charge of by the CPF members. This was with regards to jackets, torches, etc. Brigadier Dladla mentioned that all property used by the CPF will be controlled by police and that it is available at all times. CPF members cannot keep the equipment themselves.

Meeting closed with a prayer.

On my arrival I found that there was no active Community Police Forum structure in place and therefore no minutes could be obtained for the periods – January, February, March, April, May, June, July, August, September and October 2010. The Station Commander at the time, Brigadier Mlenga, myself and Constable Gama, who also handled Communication Services at that time, did our utmost best to call for an Annual General Meeting (AGM) in order to get the Forum up and running.

Three AGM's were conducted. The first one in Khayelitsha, for both Site B and Site C. Afterwards it was decided upon to rather host two individual AGM's for both these areas. Both these AGM's were handled by the Department of Community Safety, as an independent body at the time. The AGM in Site C could not proceed because of a lack of interest by the community. The Site B AGM took place and a Committee established. Yet again, various political influences caused a lack in attendance and the Department of Community Safety were called yet again to intervene.

4.

The first monthly meetings where the EXCO and Sub-Forums were well in attendance only came off the ground during 2011. We were met by challenges at the time but can freely state that at present, we have a well established and active CPF. Our next AGM will take place on the 8th of November 2012. Only certain posts will be voted in as the National CPF Constitution states that a CPF Exco serves for a period of 5 years.


