(e) promote values, information and preventive work aimed at fighting doping;

(f) contribute to research related to the object of its activities;

(j) promote the integrity of a drug-free sport.

2. In exercising this mandate the agency shall—

(a) form such committees as shall be necessary for the execution of its mandate;

(b) source for funding;

(c) enter into agreements with any other agency or institution as shall be necessary;

(d) prepare such rules of procedure and regulations to govern its operations; and

(e) have the power to acquire assets.

Executive Summary

Under sections 59(1) (d), 59(1) (f), 59(3) and 59(5) of the County Government Act, 2012 the Board is required to report to the County Assembly on the discharge of its functions and, extent to which values and principles of Articles 10 and 232 are complied with in the County Public Service. To discharge its mandate, the Board was assisted by the three committees and the four operational departments headed by the secretariat staff under the leadership of the acting Board Secretary. The Committees were; Human Resource Development and Management, Finance Administration Planning and welfare and Compliance governance and relationships while the departments were; Administration, Information Communication and Technology, Finance and Accounts and, Public Relations.

During the year under review, the Board was expected to undertake various programmes and activities aimed at strategically managing entry, progression, conduct and exit of persons in the County Public Service. In undertaking these programs the Board was guided by its vision, mission, and core values. The Board undertook institutional analysis and is in the process of developing a five year strategic plan and citizens' service charter that will prioritize service delivery to the clients into four thematic areas of; Promotion of constitutionalism and good governance in the County Public Service, transformation in service delivery in the County Public Service, equitable distribution of opportunities and, development of institutional capacities.

The Board has so far handled a total of 810 jobs in this year alone. 108 persons were to be taken through suitability test for confirmation after serving under the defunct Economic Stimulus Package (ESP) and the Capacity Bridge Project (CBP) in the health and pastoral economy sectors. 332 jobs were entry appointments in the ministry of Education and health as well as Nairobi Liaison office. The Board has rolled out a total of 370 jobs to be awarded to the deserving candidates in 2015.

THE TURKANA COUNTY PUBLIC SERVICE BOARD

Mandate

The mandate of the Board is as provided in section 59 (1) of the County Government Act 2012 as acting on behalf of the County Government to:

- Establish and abolish offices in County Public Service.

- Appoint persons to hold or act in offices in County Public Service including in the board of cities and urban areas within the county and to confirm appointments.

To establish and maintain adequate, professional and competent workforce for quality and effective service delivery, realization of County development goals and fostering national unity

Core value

The purpose of this service charter will be achieved by adopting the following six core values;

- Competence
- Confidentiality
- Transparency and Accountability
- Professionalism
- Equity and Diversity
- Continual improvement

Discharge of mandate of Board for the year ending 31st Dec 2014

1) Internal operations

In the year under review, there were four internal undertakings that significantly contributed to effective discharge of the Boards' mandate. These were; development of a five year strategic plan for the period between 2014 and 2019, signing of the performance contract with the County Governor, development of service charter and service charter commitment document and, human resource capacity building through trainings and workshops. However, there were a number of challenges and emerging issues that hampered the operations of the Board as discussed here below.

Strategic Planning

The Board :

- Developed a draft copy of the first five year strategic plan for the period 2014-2019;
- Prioritized four main themes to be achieved in the five year strategic plan period with respect to;
 - promotion of constitutionalism and good governance in the County Public Service,
 - transforming service delivery methods and standards by the employees of the County Public Service,
 - equitable distribution of opportunities in the County Public Service and,
 - development of institutional and/or organizational capacity.

- Identified finance and resource insufficiency as a possible risk to the full implementation of the Strategic Plan for which it was proposed that financing and resource mobilization be approached from four levels. These are; County government as the principle financier at 80% contribution, development partners as complimentary financiers at 10% contribution, stakeholders as supplementary financiers at 8% contribution and, service levy and charges as petty financiers at 2% contribution.
- Outlined four key areas as the desired results that can be used to measure performance of the Board and make the necessary adjustments where possible. These Key Result Areas (KRAs) are; Improvement of the governance index in the County Public Service, Reduction of the gap in county HR requirements, Increase representativeness in the County Public Service and, build relational, managerial and operational capacity of the Board.
- Projected that at the end of its term and/or full implementation of the Strategic Plan, the possible outcome that will be realized are; A transparent, accountable and ethical County Public Service. Adequate, competent and effective HR for the county. An all-inclusive County Public Service and, efficient and effective County Public Service Board that can qualify for ISO certification and any other quality service delivery award.

Performance Contracting

The Board:

- Prepared performance contract and the necessary annual work plan documents for the year 2014/2015 in line with the proposed strategic plan for all its members, departments and committees undertaking internal and external obligations.
- Signed the prepared performance contract with the County Governor as a sign of commitment to the framework for promoting accountability and transparency in the County Public Service.
- Initiated internal consultations on how best to undertake performance tracking of both internal and external obligations as well as regularity of submitting reports to the Performance Contracting/review arm of the Board and County Government.

Clients' charter and commitment to service delivery

The Board:

- Complied with the relevant provisions and legislations that justified the preparation, publication and communication of service charter document such as; performance contract which required the Board to pledge continuous improvement in pursuit of client satisfaction; Strategic plan which required the Board to enhance operational effectiveness; The constitutional obligation of promoting values and principles of Articles 10 and 232 and, the need to provide a platform for dialogue and/or communication with clients on service delivery.
- Prepared the first draft copies of the first citizens' service charter and service charter commitment documents to define the standards for service delivery in both operational and constitutional obligations.
- Designed the service charter and the service charter commitment documents to; Create public and clients awareness on the Boards' functions; Give insights on the vision, mission and core values of the Board; Avail information on the range of services offered by the Board; Communicate standards for service delivery; Outline the Board's client's expectations and; Provide a platform for dialogue on service delivery and, suggestion of remedies where services fall short of desired standards.
- Outlined the product and range of services offered by the Board as follows;

- Preparation, issuance and distribution of service regulations.
- Establishment and abolition of offices in the County Public Service in consultation with other relevant county departments.
- Appointments and re-designations of personnel in the County Public Service.
- Managing the needs and work related affairs of officers on Transfer of service and secondment to the County.
- Performing regular HR audits to investigate monitor and evaluate the organization and administration of personnel practices of the County Public Service.
- Hearing and determining appeals in respect to discharge of Boards' mandate.
- Determination of discipline cases including appeals and reviews.
- Extension of Service for officers on contract.
- Promotion, compliance evaluation and reporting to the County Assembly on values and principles of Articles 10 and 232.
- Implementation of the Public Officer Ethics Act, 2003 including the administration of the Public Officer Code of Conduct and financial declarations in the County Public Service.
- Addressing complaints and grievances relating to human resource functions in the County Public Service.
- Approving retirement from the Service for county civil servants on the basis of the '60' Year Rule, ill health, re-organization of Government or abolition of office and in the Public interest.
- Setting of qualifications and conditions of service.
- Design and implement performance management plan in the County Public Service in consultation with the relevant county departments.
- Review of codes of conduct for the public service.
- Offer advisory services to the County government on human resource management and development and, administration/review of performance appraisal tools.
- Publication of an Annual Magazine called 'The County Servant.'
- Making a case to the SRC on behalf of the County government on salaries and remuneration of employees.

Human resource development and training

During the period under review, the board carried out capacity building for its members and the secretariat staff by; availing training opportunities, organizing group workshops and seminars and bench marking visits.

Emerging issues and challenges

During the year under review the Board faced a number of hampering challenges in the discharge of its constitutional mandate. The challenges included-

- Delayed disbursement of funds to the Board for implementation of programme.
- Inadequate budgetary allocation.
- Lack of Human Resource Management Officers (HRMO).
- Inadequate office space.
- Lack of organographic guidelines, policies and advisories for staffing County Government Ministries/Departments.
- Meeting expectations of the Boards' stakeholders and general public.
- Difficulty in ensuring equitable distribution of the few job opportunities among counties and region
- Difficulty of addressing gender parity problem in senior positions in public service making it difficult to meet the two thirds ($\frac{2}{3}$) constitutional requirement in appointments.

- Inconsistent exchequer releases due to austerity measures.
- Unpredictable and slow volume of work from the Ministries and departments of the County Government.
- Reception of few applications from persons living with disability hence making it difficult to include them in the County Public Service.
- Lack of organographic recruitment plans from Ministries and departments of the County Government.

(2) Appointments and recruitments

(a) Number of vacancies handled in the year 2014.

The vacancies handled in the year 2014 were 1,117 from all the departments of Turkana county government. 743 (66.5%) jobs were successfully determined, 340 (30.5%) are still in process while 34 (3%) others are to be re-advertised.

Preamble

This report is prepared in accordance with the Constitution and section 59 (1) (d) and (f) and subsection (5) of section 59 of County Government Act (No. 17 of 2012) which states that the County Public Service Board shall:

59 (1) (d) prepare regular reports for submission to the county assembly on the execution of the functions of the Board.

59 (1) (f) evaluate and report to the County Assembly on the extent to which the values and principles referred to in Articles 10 and 232 are complied with in the county public service.

It is a requirement under section 59 (5) (a) of the County Governments Act (2012) that each County Public Service Board must deliver a report to the respective County Assembly in the month of December each year. The scope of the report which is itemized in the section 59 (5) (b-f) (Annex I) is primarily on the extent to which the county is implementing the promotion and protection of the principles and values elicited in Articles 10 and 232 of the Constitution This

report meets all the requirements in section 59 sub section (5) of the county Government Act.

Preface

This report covers the period between July and December, 2013, a time of transition in the history of the County and the Nation in general. Indeed, the promulgation of the new constitution ushered in a new era in the governance of the Republic of Kenya. One key change introduced by this dawn was devolution. Following the passage of the constitution, several Laws have been passed by the national assembly, as envisaged by the same constitution, to actualize and implement it including rolling out devolution. Some of the Laws operationalizing devolution include the County Government Act 2012, the Transition to County Government Act and the Transition Act.

On the 4th of March 2013, devolution became a reality to Kenya when Kenyans, through the ballot, voted for their first leaders under the devolved system of government. Since then, the County governments were established and first Governors sworn in. Subsequently, other organs and institutions that will deliver functions to this government were then sworn in. One such institution is the County Public Service Board. Elgeyo Marakwet County Public Service Board came into existence on 25th June 2013, when its members were sworn in. This report covers the period from then to 31st December 2013.

As one of the organs responsible for the transition into a new government, the EMC-CPSB has taken this role with speed and diligence. As detailed in this report, the board has been instrumental in selection of chief-officers, filling positions in the County organization structure, delivering an HR planning strategy to the county, developing a board charter, establishing and adopting terms of reference for digital system for recruitment, selection and performance management. The board has also established structures and frameworks that will enable the county have an efficient and vibrant public service that is capable of service to its citizens.

As we embarked on establishing our county structures, it has not been without challenges. As at the close of 2013, the EMC CPSB did not have a budget, offices nor a secretariat.

The County Public Service Board has worked with the County Executive and the County Assembly through the CASB on several frontiers. We report that the task has been both challenging and exciting. We have shepherded and lived up to the values as enriched in the constitution, and we are continuously committed to ensuring that we have put in place structures to safeguard the constitution and all other Laws of the land.

Statement from the Board Secretary

Elgeyo Marakwet County Public Service Board was established under Chapter 13 Article 235 of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 and section 57 of the County Government Act of 2012. It consists of the chairman, Vice-chairman and four other members appointed by the Governor with the approval of the County Assembly. The Board is required under Article 59 (1) (d) to prepare regular reports for Submission to the County Assembly on the execution of the functions of the Board. This introduces an accountability framework on the discharge of the Board's mandate.

Upon its inauguration, the Board started discharging its mandate. Since then, the bulk of the Board's activities have entailed setting up modalities to enable it discharge its mandate. To this end, the Board formulated its Charter, came up with its Vision, Mission, slogan and Core Values, and designed the Structure of the Secretariat which is expected to be filled in the coming year. To build the capacity of Board members, to establish strategic partnership and to cultivate an environment of mutual cooperation, the Board attended various induction trainings and made visits. Notable among this being the visit made to PSC headquarters Nairobi, and the visit received from the SRC Chairman and Commissioners.

During the period, some of the Board's key achievements include: advisories to the executive on HR planning, framework on job evaluation, CIDP, and performance management; recruitment of key positions and ECD teachers; staff headcount, amongst others.

In the discharge of its mandate the Board faced a number of challenges which included lack of office space; lack of a secretariat; and managing expectations of all stakeholders. The Board is aware of the high expectations on service delivery and prudent management of county public service.

BACKGROUND—ELGEYO MARAKWET COUNTY PUBLIC SERVICE BOARD

EMC-CPSB has been established pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 Chapter 13 Article 235, and the County Government Act 2012 Sec 57. The EMC Assembly approved the nominees for the board positions on 18th June 2013, which was gazetted by H.E. Eng. Alex Tolgos, the Governor of Elgeyo Marakwet County on 21st June 2013 via Kenya Gazette Notice No. 8644. Subsequently, the board members were sworn in on 25th June 2013.

The Board consists of the Chairman, Vice-chairman, four members, and a board Secretary. The board's operations are undertaken in accordance with the Board Charter and the relevant legislations. To deliver on its mandate, the board has established four committees, namely:

1. Recruitment, Retention, and performance management committee
2. Employee relations and disciplinary committee.
3. Finance, Administration and Governance Committee.
4. Agenda and Liaison Committee.

FUNCTIONS OF THE COUNTY PUBLIC SERVICE BOARD

As per County Government Act 2012 Sec 59, the functions of the County Public Service Board shall be, on behalf of the county government, to—

1. Establish and abolish offices in the county public service;
2. Appoint persons to hold or act in offices of the county public service including in the boards of cities and urban areas within the county and to confirm appointments;
3. Exercise disciplinary control over, and remove, persons holding or acting in those offices as provided for under this part;
4. Prepare regular reports for submission to the county assembly on the execution of the functions of the board;
5. Promote in the county public service the values and principles referred to in articles 10 and 232;
6. Evaluate and report to the county assembly on the extent to which the values and principles referred to in articles 10 and 232 are complied with in the County Public Service.
7. Facilitate the development of coherent, integrated human resource planning and budgeting for personnel emoluments in counties;
8. Advise the county government on human resource management and development;
9. Advise county government on implementation and monitoring of the national performance management system in counties; make recommendations to the salaries and remuneration commission, on behalf of the county government, on the remuneration, pensions and gratuities for county public service employees.

POWERS OF COUNTY PUBLIC SERVICE BOARD

In the performance of its functions, the County Public Service Board shall have powers to—

1. Inform and educate county public officers and the public about the values and principles;
2. Recommend to the county government effective measures to promote the values and principles;
3. Assist county government in the formulation and implementation of programs intended to inculcate in public officers the duty to uphold the values and principles;
4. Advise the county government on their obligations under international treaties and conventions on good governance in the county public service.
5. Visit any county public office or body with a view to assessing and inspecting the status of compliance with the values and principles;
6. Investigate, on its own initiative or upon a complaint made by any person or group of persons, the violation of any values and principles;
7. Recommend to the relevant lawful authority, any necessary action in view of the violation of the values and principles by any person or public body;
8. Cooperate with other institutions working in the field of good governance in the public service; and
9. Perform any other functions as the board considers necessary for the promotion of the values and principles.

HEAD COUNT REPORT

A total of 1,381 persons were counted during the headcount exercise undertaken between August and September 2013. Of those counted, 1198 were from the devolved functions previously handled by national government and 183 from the defunct Local Authorities of Marakwet County Council, Iten/Tambach Town Council and Keiyo County Council.

Of the devolved functions staff counted, 922 had been assigned to Elgeyo Marakwet County while 276 had not been assigned as per the Public Service Commission List. A further analysis of the unassigned staff counted indicated that these were staff employed under Special

programs, with the most employees belonging to the devolved ministry of Health.

271 staff members assigned to EMC were not counted during the exercise. The boards is in the process of ascertaining their actual status. The table below summarizes the headcount by status (Assigned/ Unassigned) and Verification (Counted / not Counted)

Distribution by Academic qualification and Department

10% of the staff have bachelors degree qualification and above while 39% are diploma holders. Majority of the staff counted (43%) have form four education certificate while 8% have standard eight or equivalent qualification.

On the distribution by ministry / department, ministry of health accounts for the bulk of the staff (66%); followed by Agriculture, Livestock and fisheries at 16%. The remainder is distributed to the 7 departments each accounting for under 5%.

CHALLENGES

During the period between July and December 2013, the Board faced a number of challenges in the discharge of its mandate under the County Government Act. These challenges include:

- Lack of office space; Chairman and Secretary are currently accommodated at the Governor's office complex.
- Absence and/or conflicting guidelines managing transition.
- Managing varied stakeholder expectations.
- Harmonization of the different schemes of service of former Local Authorities staff and those of staff in the devolved functions.
- Limited response to some advertised positions makes it difficult to meet the 1/3rd gender/people with disability threshold and regional balance while upholding merit and competence.

SHORT TERM PLANS

Within this fiscal year, the board intends to accomplish the following:
