a) The Pressings.

The council agreed in principle that the Appleford Parish Trust could provide for clearance work, landscaping and new gym equipment at the Recreation Ground at the Chambrai Close end, subject to full plans being provided to the council for formal approval. The Trust must give full details of the equipment proposed so the council can investigate possible insurance liabilities.
