

TULLYNESSLE 50/50 CLUB PRIVACY NOTICE

Tullynessle & Forbes Community Hall ("The Hall") are the Data Controller of the personal data collected and processed by us. This Privacy Notice explains how we collect, use and keep personal data obtained in relation to the Tullynessle 50/50 Club.

1 WHAT INFORMATION DO WE COLLECT AND HOW IS IT USED?

In order for individuals to register to participate in the 50/50 Club, The Hall will collect your name, address, email address and telephone number, via the Application Form. The Hall may also require details of your bank account, in order to process any payment should you be selected as a winner.

You will be required to agree to the 50/50 Club Rules and provide confirmation that you are over 16.

Personal data is stored in a range of different places, including our 50/50 Club files, accounting system and email system, but is subject to controls to ensure security and prevent unauthorised access and/or disclosure.

When registering for the 50/50 Club, you will be asked to consent to your details being published, in the event that you win a prize. You have the right for this information to not be published and if you choose not to consent to this, it will not affect your participation in the 50/50 Club.

Please be assured that we will never buy, sell or trade personal data to any third parties.

2 WHY DO WE PROCESS PERSONAL DATA?

Your personal data is processed for the following purposes:

- To fulfil a contract for our services, e.g. to become a member of the 50/50 Club
- To comply with legal or regulatory requirements, such as to process payment for the 50/50 Club
- To communicate with 50/50 Club Members, based on our legitimate interests;
- To publish winners, provided the winner has consented

3 WHO HAS ACCESS TO YOUR DATA?

Your information will be shared internally with the Board, only if access to the data is necessary for performance of their roles.

On occasion, we may be legally required to share personal data i.e. in the course of a criminal or legal investigation.

We may disclose your personal data to third parties who provide us with goods and/or services, including IT service providers, payroll and financial/accountancy providers.

Where we engage third party suppliers to process data on our behalf, we do so on the basis of written instructions, ensuring the third party has implemented appropriate technical and organisational measures to ensure the security of data.

Any sharing of personal data is subject to appropriate due diligence assessments, along with the implementation of contractual and confidentiality controls.

4 HOW DO WE PROTECT YOUR DATA?

The Hall have implemented controls to ensure that your data is not lost, accidentally destroyed, misused or disclosed, and is not accessed except by our Board members in the performance of their duties.

5 FOR HOW LONG DO WE KEEP YOUR DATA?

The Hall will hold data relating to the 50/50 Club for the duration of our contractual relationship with you and for a period of 7 years thereafter, as per HMRC rules.

In the case of queries or questions, data will be retained to enable a timely response and will not be retained thereafter.

In cases where data is held for a longer period of time, where there is a legal or regulatory reason to do so, data will be deleted when it is no longer required for the legal or regulatory purpose it was held for.

6 YOUR RIGHTS

As a data subject, you have a number of rights, in certain circumstances as follows:

- to withdraw your consent with regard to publishing winners details
- access and obtain a copy of your data on request;
- to change incorrect or incomplete data;
- to delete or stop processing your data, for example where the data is no longer necessary for the purposes of processing;
- object to the processing of your data in certain circumstances
- to stop processing data for a period if data is inaccurate or there is a dispute about whether or not your interests override our legitimate grounds for processing data.
