A828 CONNEL TO BALLACHULISH TRUNK ROAD - CONNEL BRIDGE OVERHEAD WORKS

BEAR Scotland, acting on behalf of Transport Scotland, are planning to carry out essential works to replace one damaged overhead steel cross beam and a section of damaged parapet on A828 Connel Bridge. In order to reduce disruption; BEAR Scotland will also be undertaking vital repairs and maintenance to the street lighting system over the length of the bridge during the same period. The works will commence on the evening of Monday 16th March 2015 at 24:00 hours and last until 06:00 hours the following morning. This will be repeated for a further four nights, it is expected that the works will finish at 06:00 hours on Saturday morning 21st March 2015.

While we acknowledge the inconvenience, the road will be closed to both vehicles and pedestrians during these times as it will be dangerous to cross when overhead welding and lifting is taking place. The sub-contractor will start operations at Midnight and work through the night continuously.

Access for fire, police and ambulance vehicles on emergency duties only will be provided. A dedicated site mobile telephone number will be provided to the emergency services in order to pre-warn the site of any incident so that the bridge can be cleared. Where possible; 15 minutes' notice should be provided.

If, due to adverse weather conditions, the works cannot be carried out; the bridge will remain open as usual.
