Competition Rules updated and effective from 26th November 2023

GENERAL RULES

1. Maximum of 3 images per person per competition, one of which is designated as a reserve. Should the number of entries for a competition exceed 70, all reserve images will be withdrawn.
2. Images can be submitted in colour or mono, unless otherwise stated. (Some competitions may be for mono only).
3. All Competitions (revised 23rd November 2023)

All photographic work must be entirely the original work of the author and not a copy or derived from the work of another person. Members must have originated and own the copyright of all work submitted, including all components of composite photographs whether assembled by traditional or digital means.
The inclusion of 'copyright free' images or 'clip art' is not acceptable.
4. Images are to be taken by the member within two years of the competition date. (Unless otherwise stated for a particular competition).
5. Competitions are only open to fully paid up members.
6. No image may be entered in more than one competition in one year. (Unless otherwise stated for a particular competition).
7. Images should reflect the subject title of the competition. Expect your score to be marked down if the judge(s) feel this is not the case.

PRINT IMAGES

1. Print images must be presented to the competition secretary, no later than the time requested on the night of the competition, to enable them to be displayed prior to judging. (Currently 7.20pm).
2. All entries must be mounted on card (preferably with a backboard) or foam board. Please do not affix anything else to the back of the mount which may mark other entries when sorting for a competition.
3. The mount size may be selected to display the image to the best advantage, but no larger than 500x400mm.
4. Entries MUST have the following information (preferably on a label) on the back TOP LEFT of the mount showing:-

Membership number, Number and Title of image, and Date of competition.

DIGITAL IMAGES

1. Digital images should be sent no later than the date advised by the competition secretary to allow collation into the club competition software.
2. Entries to be in SRGB format
3. Images should be saved at a resolution of 150ppi and max width of 1400 pixels and maximum height of 1050 pixels. Format to be JPEG.
4. Each image file should be saved as follows :- Image number (either 1,2 or 3) followed by a space and then the title. Do not include any punctuation.

FOR EXAMPLE.

1 Green Elephant, 2 Blue Sky, 3 White Cloud.

Please ensure when sending images to comp sec. your name is somewhere in the body of the email for identification but not in the image (file) title.
