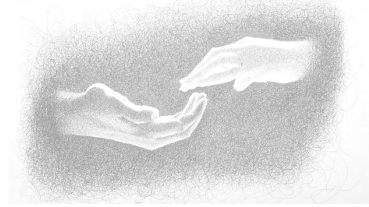

to open our eyes to fresh vision.

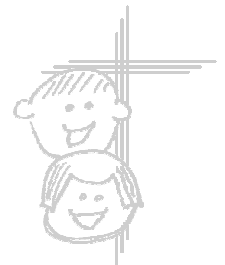
Bless us
