	Although unable to attend JM had left notes for the group about the current status of	
	Hangeliff Lane. RG was also able to let the group know that he had been discussing the	
	matter with the site "owners". The current title holder is to transfer the site to his partner	
	and if this is accepted by the Registers of Scotland it may then be possible for the Council	
	to purchase it. Until such time as the title difficulty has been fully sorted out the Council	
	cannot proceed with the plans to purchase and develop. In any event it seems that any funding available may have been lost. The Secretary will check with JM on this and	SECRETARY
	either JM or the Secretary will let the group know at the next meeting. Effectively, this	SECKETAKI
	project has be put to one side for the time being.	
5	Harrison Square	
	JM's note explained that the Council had produced some conceptual plans for the area but	
	given that they were at a very early stage, only preliminary consultation had taken place	
	and doubts about funding, he had not wished to leave the plans with the group to consider.	
	The Chairman said that he had consulted with a number of businesses about Harrison	
	Square.	
	It was agreed that at the next meeting JM could come with the drawings and the Chairman	$\mathbf{J}\mathbf{M}$
	could let the group know what the businesses were considering and what ideas they had.	CHAIRMAN
6	Church Road	
	JM's note explained that communications were still ongoing with Architecture Design	
	Scotland's Diarmid Lawlor. JM to provide an update for the next meeting.	JM
7	Action Plan: What to do from here?	
	The Chairman introduced this item by considering that there was a considerable amount of	
	work required to be done.	
	RG said that one of the greatest dangers to the town centre in particular was the	
	incremental changes that take place to the detriment of the appearance of the area. He	
	gave examples of shop signs that altered the character of the street and also the change of	
	use of the former CAB building. He felt that Shetland Islands Council should do	

	something about this, possibly by having a single point of contact for information and	
	advice.	
	The Secretary suggested that if something was noticed by any member of the group then	
	he or she could contact him and he would alert the rest of the group to see if they wanted	
	to do something about it.	
	RG said he didn't think it was appropriate for the group to act as some kind of policing	
	body.	
	Dsk asked if there was a particular person in the Council responsible for policies or if they	
	were kept in a certain place that the group could access. If the policies stated what the	
	Council should and should not do then it would be of some help to the group.	
	There was some discussion about what the Council does, or doesn't do.	
	RG would like to see a Council coordinator of all things so there is a one stop shop.	
	DSk expressed a little frustration and said that really what was needed was for the group	
	to think carefully about what it was that it wanted. Preparing a submission for a review of	
	the Local Plan was something that he knew other groups had done and this might be a way	
	ahead.	
	There was much discussion. It was decided that the Secretary should ask the Council	
	what the current status of the Local Development Plan was and the timescales for	SECRETARY
	implementation. It was also decided that it might be beneficial to have a note of planning	
	applications affecting the area to be forwarded on to the group by the Council. The	
	Chairman said he would contact the Council to ask about that.	CHAIRMAN
	Turning to the Action Plan and the projects on it, there was a great deal of discussion with	O
	little agreement or outcome. It was, however, agreed that each project should be properly	
	detailed on a pro forma grid or sheet to allow for easy access to information about each.	
	Currently, there is no structure or information reference point to allow any member of the	
	group to find out at a glance where each project lay.
