MATERIALS

1. Clock Face
2. Americana Acrylic in Indian Turquoise, Titanium White, Antique White, Milk Chocolate and Cherry Red.
3. Americana Writers in Lavender & Citron Green
4. Treasure Gold, Jones Tones foil glue and gold foil
5. Clock mechanism
6. Americana matte spray varnish

Equipment

1. Paint brushes, Nos. 4 and 6 flat. No 0 Liner brush
2. No.5 pigment pen
3. Pottery Carbon paper
4. Scissors
5. Masking tape



Cupcake time!

1 Trace the cupcake design onto the clock face using pottery carbon paper.



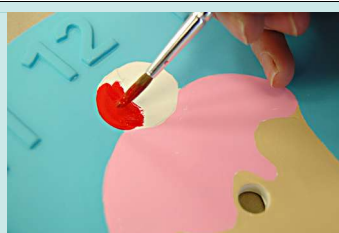
2 Base-coat the clock face and edge with two coats of Indian Turquoise avoiding the traced cupcake. Allow to dry.



3 Apply 2 coats of Baby Pink to the icing, Allow to dry between coats.



4 Apply 2 coats of Antique White to the cupcake base. Allow to dry between coats.



5 Apply 3 coats of Cherry Red to the cherry. Allow to dry between coats.



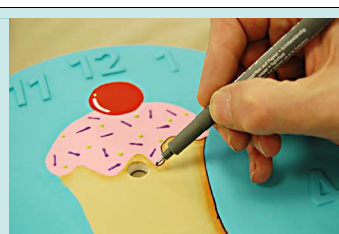
6 Side load a square shader brush with Milk Chocolate and shade the cupcake base.



7 Using a Citron Green and Lavender Americana Writer add sprinkles and dots to your icing.



8 Pick up some Titanium White with a liner brush and add a highlight to the cherry.



9 Outline and detail your cake using a number 5 Pigment pen.

Note: Standard ink pens will bleed during varnishing.

10 Gently rub Treasure Gold gilding wax onto the clock numbers and allow to dry.



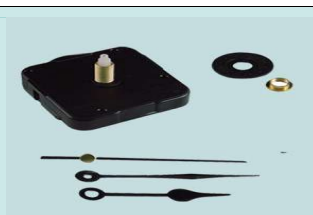
11 Spray with a coat of Americana Matte sealer and let dry for 5 minutes. Finish with a second coat.



12 Paint a thin coat of Jones Tones foil glue onto the numbers and allow to dry.



13 Apply Jones Tones gold foil to numbers by pressing and releasing several times onto numbers.



14 Once dry fit your clock mechanism and hands to the clock and its ready to hang.



15 NOTE: You could finish clock with a gloss sealer the choice is yours!

Always spray in a ventilated area or apply Americana brush on sealer.
