The main functions of the Club are to look after the interests of the Breed in Scotland, to promote classes at shows, and to foster friendliness and co-operation between members, whether they are interested in showing, breeding, or owning a hound as a much loved pet.

Each year the Club holds a Championship Show and Open Show. It also organises friendly matches with Clubs of other breeds and holds an Annual Fun Day with novelty classes and fancy dress for the dogs. Other events may be held if sufficient numbers merit. Members also receive a Newsletter (all contributions gratefully accepted!).
