066/20 MINUTES OF THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 24th JUNE 2020

067/20 MATTERS ARISING

As per updated action points. Councillor Ward was progressing the flag pole and planning permission was not required. Councillor Williams had someone who could replace the old footpath signs. It was agreed that a quote be obtained for the work.

68/20 UPDATE FROM CORNWALL COUNCIL WARD MEMBER

New signs were to go up at Tanners Lane to indicate that it was a no through road. Work would be carried out in the vicinity of the Royal Oak to address flooding issues. The drainage down to the river would be upgraded. He was meeting Natalie Ward for support for speed cameras in the parish. Money was needed to be spent. There was funding available out of a bigger pot for upgrading the road surfaces. This would be spent on Station Road, but he would welcome suggestions for anywhere else.

A complaint had been received regarding two trees at the Playing Field which were limiting the light to an adjoining property. It was agreed to ask Glen Humphreys to quote for these to be cut back.

072/20 HIGHWAYS AND FOOTPATHS

The Millennium Path was very overgrown, it was the responsibility of Cornwall Council to deal with the roadside of the hedge, but the Parish Council has previously had the inside cut back. Glen Humphreys to be asked to quote. Councillor Fox said that the triangle at West Park needed attention. The cycle lane through the chicane at School Hill had now been dealt with by the Parish Council. Tree roots from the Village Hall car park were breaking up the surface of the pavement at School Hill.

The Emergency Plan coordinators were still concerned with those who were isolated and did not have access to the internet or did not wish to use it. Councillor Williams mentioned a letter of thanks received from the daughter of a local resident who used the buddy scheme through Lockdown.
