7. HIGHWAYS & FOOTPATHS

a. ROADS

- 1. The Squirrels, St Pirans Hill The verge outside this property has been grassed and posts concreted into the ground to prevent access however it is understood that Highways have concluded that this verge is part of the Highway and they wrote to the landowner in November 2012 but nothing has happened since. It was agreed that the Clerk should follow this up with Highways to see what the situation is.
- 2. The clerk reported a notice from Highways of a road closure for Greenwith Hill between St Pirans Hill and Greenwith Road which is actually Chapel Hill will be closed between 13 -22 March 2013 (0730-1800 hours)

b. FOOTPATHS

- 1. Footpath 11 still missing a footpath sign
- 2. Footpath 1 towards the church needs trimming from top stile to gateway
- 3. Footpath 23 has a low branch hanging down which needs clearing
- 4. Footpath 7 bar over stile prevents less agile using footpath and Ranger has reviewed stile and discussions have been held with regard to replacing the bar with a drop down bar to enable people to get over easier however this entails a cost to the Parish as it will be an improvement not a repair (which would have been the responsibility of the landowner). The landowner is not prepared to make a contribution to the costs and in light of the potential further costs if other stiles need "improvement" it was agreed that the Parish Council could not agree to incurring such costs (£275) unless a full investigation of the total costs would be. In the meantime the Ranger has offered at no cost to the Parish to erect
- 5. The clerk presented three possible options for a seat 2 of which are available from stock from Carnon downs Garden Centre. It was decided that we should have the Turnberry Bench in Mahogany at a cost of £299.99 (inc VAT) from Carnon Downs. We have also received a second quote for the concrete slab and fixing the bench to the slab from Glenn Humphries Landscaping Ltd for £290 + VAT which is a lot lower than the previous quote obtained and it was agreed to go ahead with this supplier. The clerk was asked to arrange the purchase and installation of the bench. £256 has been promised from Mr C Ridgers fund against this cost.
- 6. The clerk presented quotes from Jan Wilkins and Glenn Humphries Landscaping Ltd for the maintenance of the footpaths and in the latters case the grass cutting for the parish. There was very little difference between the quotes and as such it was decided to remain with the current suppliers.
