150/17 MINUTES OF THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 30th AUGUST 2017

On the proposition of Councillor Burn, seconded by Councillor Kneebone, the Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on 30th August 2017 were approved and signed.

152/17 UPDATE FROM CORNWALL COUNCIL WARD MEMBER

Councillor Williams had asked Viv Bidgood to ensure that the cuttings from the top of the Millennium Path hedge should be taken away. He had requested that the pavement outside the shop should be resurfaced properly as he considered the current state of it to be dangerous. It was on the schedule, but he had been told that for the last three years.

He had been to a briefing regarding crowd funding and thought this might be useful for raising money for the playing field.

The two exits at Treluswell were down to one causing a big delay. He advised that the parish council should check at the meeting with Viv Bidgood about the proposed mirror at the junction of St Pirans Hill and School Hill. The proposed mirror at Cove hill was approved. West Park was due to be resurfaced. He had now got the planings and they would be going in the Church car park for use anywhere in the parish. There was 10 tons available. The Chairman thought it

would be a good idea to mention this in the Perran News in case anywhere needed it. The church could always use it if it was not required elsewhere. Councillor Davey agreed that the pavement outside the shop needed attention, it was a danger for the elderly. She also said that the cuttings should be removed to stop them smothering the new growth. Councillor Williams had asked that all the footpaths in the parish be assessed. He had also attended a planning presentation regarding more biodiversity ideas in planning applications. Such things as bat boxes, blocks for mice and insects etc. He extended an invitation for any councillor to have a guided tour of the St Denys incinerator. It was agreed that this would wait until more councillors were in attendance.

On the proposition of Councillor Davey seconded by Councillor Kneebone, the Minutes of the Planning Meeting on 23rd August 2017 were approved and signed. The next Planning Meeting was on 4th October.

He had a list of issues to be raised, moss, the Millennium Path hedge, footpaths, drains especially five outside the old Post Office, the gully mentioned by Mrs Simms behind her property.

Councillor Burn asked if something could be done re the overhanging branches at the bottom of Tarrandene Lane which he thought could be dangerous.

161/17 PARISH FOOTPATH MAP

The Clerk said that she had been contacted by the Secretary of the Perranarworthal History Group who were interested in producing a footpath map. As the Friends of Perranwell Station had also expressed an interest, she wondered whether they could join forces on this, with the Parish Council perhaps supporting it financially. It was agreed that this could be considered at a future meeting and the Clerk would put the other two groups in touch.

162/17 COUNCILLORS AND CLERK'S ITEMS (for information only)

Councillor Davey thought it would be good to have a seed project. She had also been approached by Cornwall College for a possible swift survey in the parish. This would involve looking at the churches and school.

The Chairman asked if the Clerk would check on the Code of Conduct training that he had down for the 19th October. This was the same night as the Big Village review.

He then gave details of a meeting attended at Feock Parish regarding a community transport scheme which they had been running for some three years. 17% of their clients actually came from Perranarworthal so he thought there might well be need for this parish to set up its own scheme. Mylor had just started something similar.
