Additional information regarding the agenda for the meeting being held on Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> August 2019 at 7pm at Graig Community Hall (Item No 6 on the agenda)

This report lists items which remain issues that are being monitored and progressed when possible. Items will only be removed once resolved. Any updates during the month will be detailed below the list.

- 1. Additional lighting on Caerphilly Road and Laurel Road (Jan '14)
- 2. Dirty Highway Signage (Oct '16)
- 3. Adoption of footpaths (Numerous times from July '11)
- 4. Overgrown footpath from Woodland Drive to Penylan Close (as above)
- 5. St Basil's Roundabout bollards repair (Feb '17)
- 6. Pentrepoeth Road issues (Oct '16)
- 7. Section 106 funding (Jul '17)
- 8. Laurel Road bollard repair (January '19)
- 9. Maintenance at Grosvenor Road underpass (Oct '18)

## **Current Month updates:**

Items 3 & 4 – Confirmation has been received that the process for 2 paths Council has been attempting to have recognised as PROWs has been completed and these are now adopted PROWs. This should mean that both the path from Woodland Drive to Fort View play area and from Caerphilly Road to Penylan Close should be maintained by NCC in future. Both these items will be removed from future reports.

Item 5 – It has been decided that the bollards will not be repaired at this time, a solution will be considered once the roundabout has been upgraded. This is planned to take place in coming months.

Item 8 – Council has agreed to replace/relocate the damaged bollards which Cllr Fry has agreed to oversee. They will be replaced in due course.

Item 9 – NetworkRail have advised that they believe the missing coping stones for the underpass are the responsibility of NCC Highways. The Clerk has written to NCC to make enquiries and been given a reference number but no other response to date. The Clerk has chased and hopes to bring news to the meeting.
