Additional information to the agenda for the meeting being held on Wednesday 30th March 2016 at 7pm at Graig Community Centre, Bassaleg (**Item No 4 on the agenda**)

1. Play Areas – A meeting with the NCC Officer in charge of the play area installations has still not taken place. Issues are on hold until the land of the former Rhiwderin play area has been purchased but this has proved to be problematic. The meeting is now expected to take place during April.

14. Armco barrier near bridge over River Ebbw - NCC have agreed that the steep drop to the river is unacceptable and are looking to have the barrier extended to eliminate the danger. This item will remain on the report until works are completed.

There has been no movement on the following items, but these are being closely monitored and any progress will be detailed on future Clerk's Reports.

2. Coach House on Caerphilly Road in Bassaleg

3. Crash Barrier on Pentre Tai Road by Level Crossing

4. Weed killing on Pentre Tai Road

5. Cycle Path by Bassaleg School

6. Parking on grass verges on Laurel Road

7. Adoption of footpath at the top of Highfield Lane

8. Forge Road bus stop and lay by signage

9. Former Garthfield Cottage site fencing and footpath

10. Boundary fencing along Caerphilly Road between the Rhiwderin Inn and Laurel Road Junction

11. Dog fouling signage

12. Dedicated right turn into Laurel Drive

13. Possible solar farm at Rhiwderin

All the above issues (with the exception of Items 2 & 13) are being discussed with the Cabinet Member for Streetscene. Since the very positive meeting with her, progress is not forthcoming. Despite the frustration Council will continue to lobby to have these issues attended to as soon as possible and are being chased regularly.
