This report lists items which remain issues that are being monitored and progressed when possible. Items will only be removed once resolved. Any updates during the month will be detailed below the list.

1. Additional lighting on Caerphilly Road and Laurel Road (Jan '14)
2. Dirty Highway Signage (Oct '16)
3. St Basil's Roundabout bollards repair (Feb '17)
4. Pentrepoeth Road issues (Oct '16)
5. Section 106 funding (Jul '17)
6. Maintenance at Grosvenor Road underpass (Oct '18)
7. Bassaleg Roundabout maintenance (Oct '19)
8. Overgrowth opposite Garth Terrace, Bassaleg (Nov '19)
9. Overgrowth of residential boundary hedge alongside steps and footpath from Penylan Close to Caerphilly Rd Bassaleg.

Current Month updates:

Item 6, NCC have not replaced the flagstones as hoped. The Clerk inspected the area last week and it is safe and reasonably tidy. Clerk to ask again if this work will be carried out, but as the wall was inspected by NCC and deemed to be completely safe, the expected response will be that is an unnecessary expense and will not be completed. The Clerk did highlight that replacing the flagstones is not just for cosmetic reasons, that it would help keep the wall in good condition and deter water ingress.

Item 8, Cllr Williams has requested NCC consider placing an enforcement case to ensure the land to the right of the steps into Penylan Close is cleared up by the owner.

Item 9. Cllr Williams to speak with homeowner to have the overgrowth trimmed back.
