

FREE ENERGY MONITORS



Community Action Northumberland, working in partnership with British Gas and National Energy Action (NEA is a registered charity) received 6,000 Energy monitors to distribute to Northumberland residents FREE OF CHARGE. 2,000 of these monitors were allocated to the Tynedale area and some were distributed by Stocksfield Institute and Community Association.

The Council was approached by Mr Norman Hooks to ask if we would like to help distribute the Energy Monitors as they had exhausted their channels of circulation and still had some remaining. On approval of the chair we promoted the FREE Energy Monitors via our website, on the People of Prudhoe Facebook Page, in the Spetchells Centre and the Hexham Courant kindly published a news brief. We also proactively approached groups within the Spetchells Centre and offered monitors when reimbursing pensioners under the TVLS refund.

The monitors have a market value of approximately £40 and can help keep track of electricity usage. They are very easy to install and you don't have to be a British Gas customer to qualify; we still have some remaining.

Since receiving the monitors on 29th February we have allocated over 200 and the response from members of the public has been very positive.
