Hello Sarah,

I hope all is well since we last met.

Whilst work is still progressing well with the first phase of Cottier Grange, we are also working on the planning for Phase 2. I've attached a plan showing our street naming proposals and would welcome any comments the PTC have before we submit a street naming application to Northumberland County Council.

In line with PTC's previous suggestion, we've chosen to refer to either former or existing physical features within this area of the site.

- **Pavilion Rise & Field Close** refer to the former sports pitch and associated pavilion/social club building that were in this area.
- **Woodland View** refers to the close proximity and view of Priestclose Wood. References to 'Priestclose' have been avoided due to this name being used elsewhere in Prudhoe
- **Oakleaf Gardens** references the various of oak trees which have been retained within this area.

We've also made a historic reference for **McCoull Drive**. This one of the main routes through the estate therefore given the significance of this road in the estate, we've named this after Dr George McCoull who served as the Hospital's first Medical Superintendent.

We have made some initial enquiries with NCC and there are no objections in principle to the proposals. I would be grateful to receive PTC's feedback as soon as possible so we can commence the formal process of registering these names. Please let me know if you need any further information.
