**Replanting of the western gateway site** There are 2 areas within the gateway that could use some replanting. In keeping with the current plants I am proposing to plant one of these areas with carpet roses and the other with portentillas.

20 carpet roses @ £6.50

~~Cutting back of cornus along the western gateway~~ The cornus on the gateway has become severely overgrown and is now covering several areas of the current planted areas. I propose to cut the cornus ever year, with approximately half cut one year, then the other half the following year. This will keep the border in control and prevent the cornus from completely overtaking the rest of the planted area. Cutting only half each year also ensures that there is some colour and growth permanently visible throughout the year.
