*Hi, My name is [REDACTED] and I have been told by go north east that I have to contact my councillor regarding the complaint.*

*I live in Old Eltringham Court and have to get the bus for work mon-fri every week morning. The bus pass costs me £1,200 a year. I'm a nutritionist at Hexham General Hospital.*

*My concern is that the bus stop is unacceptable. If it rains you are absolutely drenched and you have to work in a wet uniform. As the winter nights come in it's dark in the morning when I have to get the bus and as the trees cover your view of the bus coming around the corner you nearly miss it.*

*The bus stop itself is just a pole and two paving slabs. When there's a few of us there it is hard to move and is just awful. You will understandably agree if you take a look for yourself.*

*The bus stop is vital for us living down in that area for commuting so removing it all together would be silly.*

*My idea is that we have a sheltered stop and the trees cut back. For the money we pay I think this is the least that could be done.*
