

A residential consultation was carried out following the agreement of the Town Council to include money in the Environmental Improvements Budget to enhance the environment near 83-87 Riding Dene, Mickley.

I am writing on behalf of Prudhoe Town Council to ask for your feedback on a proposed environmental improvement scheme on the grassed area adjacent to 83-87 Riding Dene, Mickley, Northumberland, NE43 7DN.

In the past we have funded a three-tier planter but more recently we located a formal bed with seasonal planting in this area, as a more cost effective alternative and a more appropriate display, in keeping with the displays at the entrance to Riding Dene.

We would like to further extend this environmental scheme and install four planters, as shown overleaf. We feel these would complement the formal beds and give a greater impact as seen from the roadside travelling from Mickley to Prudhoe, and beyond, and also in the opposite direction.

The Town Council is very passionate about enhancing the environment for residents and visitors and we hope you will welcome this scheme; we are however open to any concerns you may have and encourage you to return the slip provided with your feedback.

20 residents were consulted; nearby, over the road from and behind the proposed scheme.

- x 9 East Street (nearby)
- x 6 Main Road (over the road)
- x 5 Riding Dene (behind)

Of those written to, 7 responded.

- x 2 East Street – supported the proposal
- x 3 Main Road – supported the proposal
- x 1 Riding Dene – supported the proposal
- x 1 Riding Dene – objected on the grounds that they would block light and would look ugly if not planted in the winter.
