Robert Kay Walker

Robert's parents were Robert and Emily Walker who lived at 3 Hillfield Burnmouth. Robert Walker senior was a quarryman at Catch-a-Penny Quarry run by the Burnmouth Quarry Company.

Robert junior was described as a motor driver on his death certificate. He died when he was 23 in the County Hospital at Gordon, not of wounds sustained in the war but of TB which, like many others, he must have contracted during his time in service.

He died on the 11th of April 1946 and is buried in Ayton cemetery. Ayton MIs number 727 apply for those with the Ayton Memorial Inscriptions booklet.

He is also commemorated on the Ayton War Memorial.

Robert's name is second from the bottom of those on the Memorial.
