

Appendix 2: Secretary's Report for the period June 2015 to April 2016.

The following table shows the attendance at the AGM, held in June 2015 and at the six ordinary meetings held in June, August, October, December 2015, and February and April 2016.

- The number of members of the Council was 15 from June until August 2015, 16 for October and December, and 15 for February and April 2016.
 - The average attendance of elected members was 76%.
- There were always at least five members of the public present; the average over all meetings was eight.
- Our two guests at the April meeting were the new Postmaster and his niece who had taken over the PO that week.
- The representative of the MOD attended and provided a written report to each ordinary meeting.
- Since the reorganisation of Police Scotland and the loss of a dedicated Police Officer for our community, the police were not represented at four of our meetings, but they provided a Crime Report to each.
- Our three Local Councillors provided support throughout the year and were represented at five of the seven meetings.
