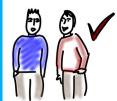
Get out and about

You will also meet your volunteer mentor. He or she will help you and your new friend from the group meet up regularly.

You will still come along to group meetings (every 6 weeks) where you will be building your confidence and speaking up. We will also be talking about good friendships and learning about Facebook and being safe.
