2	MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING & MATTERS ARISING	
	Community Planning Partnership – Dornoch Masterplan does feature.	
	Superfast Broadband – YR has met with Cameron Warren earlier in the week and scoped the exercise to see the area that can be covered dependent on where a mast is placed. Discussing options, and Cameron will now price. Suggested mast at the Scottish Water area – J McG to try to make contact with Gavin Steele.	
	Dornoch BRIG – persuing their preferred timber play area, this project is ongoing.	
	Slaughterhouse site – still has the possibility of public toilets at this site. Currently looking at a curling rink, potential wedding venue, driving range, coach park etc. RDGC have their AGM in August where much of this will need to be discussed with members.
