Hi

We did a nursery reduction scheme in around 2017/18- we removed with cherry pickers and a licensed firm from Glasgow about 200 nests in early April then again in June. It was very effective and culled the population for 2 years, with year 1 being a noticeable reduction. We did houses in Invergordon and Ales. It cost £14000 at the time.
