

## **Inverness Bowling Association and Inverness Senior League**

### **COVID Guidance (Summary)**

#### **Risk Assessment**

A risk assessment should be undertaken and displayed at the club regarding guidance for level 1. Each club will have their own interpretation.

#### **League fees**

I would recommend that there are no league fees and no hospitality provided for 2021.

#### **Hospitality**

I would suggest that everyone participating in the Senior League during 2021 bring along their own refreshment

#### **Drawing of Rinks**

The coordinator for each club will place the appropriate red and black sanitised discs on a table. Each home and away skip will indicate a disc and the coordinator will turn the selected discs and that team plays on the drawn rink.

#### **Mats**

All mats to be sanitised prior to and after play.

Where both teams are sharing a mat one end should be marked with an "X" or similar where the lead of team "A" handles the unmarked side and team "B" handles the end marked "X". Only the leads handle mats. Alternatively, each team has a mat at each end One side of the mat is marked with an "L" and the other with an "S" Team "A" handles one mat and Team "B" handles the other.

#### **Jacks**

All jacks to be sanitised prior and after play.

Each lead should have their own jack.

#### **Sanitising**

Each club should have a sanitising station and hand sanitiser should be available at either rink ends or shared between R1 & R2; R3 & R4; R5 & R6

#### **Track and Trace Folder**

All participants and attendees to sign time in and out.

#### **Scorecards**

Each home and visiting skip may use a scorecard

All names should be entered onto the scorecard

Players may compare scorecards but they should not handle or sign opposition scorecards.

The person coordinating each team shall note the scores and then the skip of each team will deposit the scorecard in the bin provided.

#### **Smoking**

No smoking or vaping within the grounds

#### **Risk**

All clubs shall take the appropriate precautions against COVID-19 and comply with guidance provided by Bowls Scotland as advised by Sports Scotland and the Scottish Government.

However, participants play at their own risk.
