

## **Senior League East v West Rules 2023**

### **EAST**

By definition all clubs affiliated to the IBA / Senior League within the City of Inverness and District affiliated to the SENIOR LEAGUE located on the EAST SIDE of the River Ness shall represent the EAST. These clubs are namely Fraser Park, Highland (Inverness) and Waterloo.

### **WEST**

By definition all clubs affiliated to the IBA / Senior League within the City of Inverness and District affiliated to the SENIOR LEAGUE located on the WEST SIDE of the River Ness shall represent the WEST.

These clubs are namely Craig Dunain, Planeftield and The Inverness.

Prior to commencement of the 2023 bowling season the Senior League and IBA merged and Glenurquhart Bowling Club was welcomed as a member and will replace Craig Dunain.

East v West games shall be played annually (time allowing) after the conclusion of the Senior League on a home and away basis, venues rotating alphabetically. Game 1 shall be played at an East Green and the return match at a West Green, rotating annually, league rule 4; greens rotating each year as follows:

2023 East games shall be played at Waterloo with the return match at The Inverness.

2024 West games shall be played at Glenurquhart and the return match at Fraser Park

2025 East games shall be played at Planeftield and the return match at Highland (Inverness).

2026 West games shall be played at The Inverness and the return match at Waterloo.

Each participating affiliated Club shall field two [2] rinks each consisting of four [4] players. However, where a club enters two [2] SIDES then that club will enter one [1] rink each consisting of four [4] players per side; league rule 3.1 shall apply when selecting players.

### **East**

Fraser Park, Highland (Inverness) and Waterloo shall each field two [2] rinks each of four [4] players

### **West**

Glenurquhart – two [2] rinks each of four [4] players

Planeftield A – one [1] rink each of four [4] players

Planeftield B – one [1] rink each of four [4] players

The Inverness - two [2] rinks each of four [4] players

Each rink shall play 12 ends and rules as per published Senior League Rules.
