

## **Interventions to minimise risk of spread of COVID-19 for onsite provision January 2021**

Measures as per main risk assessment dated Dec 2020.

In addition:

Children of key workers will be accessing the school during the current Lockdown.

They will be organised into one group – P5-7 classroom and a register will be kept.

Staff will be assigned to a group and will not move between groups in a day, if possible.

To minimise numbers of households interacting and mixing, only children who have no parent or carer at home will access keyworker provision.

Vulnerable provision will also be offered to some children. A register will be kept for each day.

Mainstream/Nursery vulnerable provision will be 9 to 12.00pm

All social distancing, ventilation and hand washing regimes should be adhered to as per main risk assessment.

- Face coverings to be worn by all adults
- 2 metre social distancing between adults
- Windows to be opened every 20 minutes to circulate air
- All rooms to have supply of spray, handsanitiser, soap
- Face masks and PPE to be worn when carrying out intimate care

Children and staff who are feeling unwell should not attend our onsite provision

Should we hear of a positive case we will follow advice from NHS Health Protection Team
