

# Mulbuie/Ferintosh

## Remote Learning Statement January 2021

### The Curriculum

#### Through remote learning we aim to:

- connect and interact with pupils' learning each day
- support pupils' well-being through encouraging connections
- continue to provide supported progressive learning in literacy and numeracy
- provide opportunity for children to have access to learning every day to reinforce and embed learning
- give structure to the day for parents who feel this useful for their children
- focus on literacy and numeracy and health and wellbeing

To do this we are using the Virtual learning wall (padlet) and Google Classrooms so that pupils can access learning personalised both to their class and to them. New learning and activities are posted daily and teachers are on hand throughout the day to provide feedback and support.

#### **Keeping in Touch with our learners**

Children are encouraged to share their work and to send pictures. Class Google Meets are held where children can get together with their teacher and classmates. Some live teaching meets are held. Some teachers post recordings of activities and lessons for the children to follow and join in.

### Equity in Learning – Pupils' with Additional Support Needs

Support staff are allocated to each child to meet/chat individually with the child or parents. Support in accessing learning has been put in place for identified pupils – some are accessing support through our Vulnerable Onsite provision and some through contact with support staff.

### Evaluations

We are currently evaluating by:

- monitoring engagement in accessing learning.
- keeping a record of contact with parents

- monitoring the quality of learning and activities that are being provided for children on the Google Classrooms

We have yet to become in a position to respond to evaluations. This will be something that we do as we move forward.
