Miss Chamberlain said she had put a notice in the local paper saying what the W.I. had done & the amount deposited in the Post Office for our local men & girls in forces, it was unanimously agreed this amount should be made up to £150 as soon as possible. The final arrangements were then made for the School childrens Xmas party.
