Who we are

The Ray Windfarm Fund Community Interest Company (CIC) has one representative from each local parish council, plus seven lay members. The Community Foundation is working with us to manage and distribute the Small Grants Programme (SGP). The CIC is responsible for any larger projects, called The Local Initiatives Fund; and establishing a Legacy Fund.

How much money is available?

The Fund receives an index-linked annual payment, started in 2018 at £270,000, amounting to around £6million over 25 years – the life of the wind farm.

You can apply for funding towards improving the situation for the people and communities in which you live. The work can be new, continuing or a one-off initiative.
