Insurance renewal

Clir Bell explained that our current insurance policy has been updated to now include a standard set of cover for local community councils meaning we are paying for cover we just don't need.

Some of the limits of cover are also much more than we need.

Cllr Bell will pursue a quote with Zurich, who have provided an indicative quote to date, to include;

- Removal of contents cover
- Gates and fences sum insured of £20,000
- Keep ground surfaces cover at £16,944
- All compulsory cover as discussed
- Change Fidelity guarantee cover to £50,000
- Enquire how much optional personal accident cover will cost and check who on the committee it covers

Cllr Wilding to check if any cover is needed for Glyn Lyn park areas, street furniture etc.

Cllr Wilding to confirm population of Glyn Llyn as Cllr Bell may need this for the insurance quote as it is a rating factor with the current insurers.
