

What should be built where and what areas should be protected.


Basis for whether planning permission should be granted for new developments.


9,570 new homes by 2036, including affordable homes



How will the city grow?


8,640 new jobs by 2036, on 77ha of employment land







Newport Replacement Local Development Plan - Preferred Strategy

Key Sites



Land east and west of Langstone Road, Llanwern is identified for mixed use development for up to 2,500 homes, a district centre, public open space and a network of Green Infrastructure.

Land south of Langstone is identified for residential development for up to 300 homes, SuDs and Green Infrastructure.
