Don't bottle things up! We can feel that if we need help that somehow we are inadequate or have failed. That though is definitely not the case. As brothers and sisters in Christ we are here to help one another. As members of the one body of Christ the members have a care and concern for other members .

Paul says in Galatians 6:2, "Bear you one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ." How can I bear my brother's burdens if I don't know what they are?

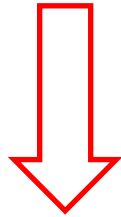
