What a Drip by Nigel Wren

When I recently opened my latest metered water bill I received a bit of a shock as it was higher than I had anticipated. I was puzzling as to why the more than expected increase when Caroline reminded me that over the winter we had a dripping tap which took a few weeks to be replaced. It reminded me that sometimes it's the small things that appear insignificant that can build up over time and make a massive difference for good or bad in our lives.

It is easy over time to make a series of wrong choices each of which seem insignificant but added together slowly, almost imperceptibly lead us from the path of doing God's will in our lives. Thankfully, God's grace in Christ can snap the chains of sin that bind and set free.

When we turn from our sin to Christ who died for us and rose again we begin the Christian life. We don't become mature as believers overnight or instantly but we grow stronger as we read the Bible and spend time in prayer and with His people. Perhaps slowly, gently, without our even being aware of it the Spirit produces in us without noise or fuss the attitudes and actions that mark our new life in Christ. Paul speaks of this in Galatians 5, "22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control, against such there is no law."
