The Cost of Living Pressures by Nigel Wren

For many individuals and families the last few months have been hard coping with price increases from every direction. For others who have not had to deal with increased housing costs and whose income has increased with inflation it has perhaps not been quite so difficult. Hopefully inflationary pressures are beginning to ease for all now.

The most dramatic account of the effects of inflation that I have read is in the Old Testament book of Haggai, 1:6, “You have sown much, and bring in little; you eat, but you have not enough; you drink, but you are not filled with drink; you clothe you, but there is none warm; and he that earns wages earns wages *to put it* into a bag with holes.”

The people of Judah had returned from exile in Babylon and had started re-building the temple in Jerusalem but due to opposition the work ceased and they set about work on their own houses. The building of the temple was a visible sign of their putting God first in their lives. Under the urging of Haggai the work re-commenced .

We are not called upon to construct a physical temple like the people of Judah were. We see clearly throughout the Bible that God who created us and sent His Son to die on the cross for our sins must have the first place in our lives. When we turn from our sins and put our faith in the risen Christ we receive Him as Lord and gladly come under His authority. Colossians 1.15-19 states that Christ must have the first place.
